

## THE COLUMBIA HISTORICAL SOCIETY BYLAWS

Preamble. -- It shall be the aim and purpose of The Columbia Historical Society to conduct its business and activities in accordance with the purposes and provisions set forth in its Constitution.

### Article I - Membership

Any person interested in the purposes of the Society may become a member by paying the annual membership fee established by the Executive Board to the Treasurer.

### Article II - Meetings

Monthly membership meetings shall be held on the second Tuesday of each calendar month.

Meetings of the Executive Board shall take place at a time and a place as may be indicated by the President. A meeting of the Executive Board may be called by two members of the Board by making a request to the President. All members of the Executive Board shall be notified in advance of any Board meeting. A quorum shall consist of three Board members in good standing.

### Article III - Parliamentary Authority

The parliamentary authority for all meetings of the Society shall be Robert's Rules of Order (Revised). These rules of order shall govern this Society in all cases in which they are not inconsistent with the Constitution or the Bylaws of the Society.

### Article IV - Amendments

These Bylaws may be amended or repealed by a two-thirds (2/3's) vote of the members present at any meeting or at a meeting called for this purpose, providing a quorum is present. Amendments and revisions shall take effect at the close of the meeting at which they were adopted.
